Candidate Agreement

- I have completed the application for membership
- My major is Accounting or Finance, or I am in the MBA/MSA/MST program
- Both my overall GPA and my major GPA are at least 3.00
- I have paid the non-refundable \$35 (chapter dues) + \$65 (national initiation fee)
- I understand the activity hour requirements

ATTENDANCE IS IMPORTANT: Remember that your participation does not stop once you become a full member. Our attendance is reviewed at the end of each semester by the Beta Alpha Psi national office, and if our percentage of attendance among members and candidates does not reach a certain limit, probationary standards are invoked. Remember that this participation is essential to your status and the status of your chapter. Members' status can be revoked. If you are unable to attend a meeting or event please inform one of the officers.

Candidates seeking membership will be responsible for paying dues each semester, even if they have not yet been initiated. Regular dues after the one-time \$65 national initiation fee are \$35 per semester.
